Lesson 1: – overview

Global issues and outlook

- Culture and Identity
- Wealth and poverty

Key question:

- What can I find out by looking at pictures?

Skills:

- Thinking
- Communication
- ICT
- Number

Resources:

- Resource 1 photograph
- Pictures from Zanzibar

Learning objectives:

- To open up discussion about global links

Learning outcomes:

- To link the ESDGC themes with the pictures

Lesson 1: – plan

Introduction:

This is a starter activity. Project the image (Resource 1) onto the whiteboard. Explain that the image has a global link. Ask the students what they think the global link might be

Activities

In small groups give each group a copy of the set of pictures
Discuss the possible global links for each picture. Record the links

Plenary:

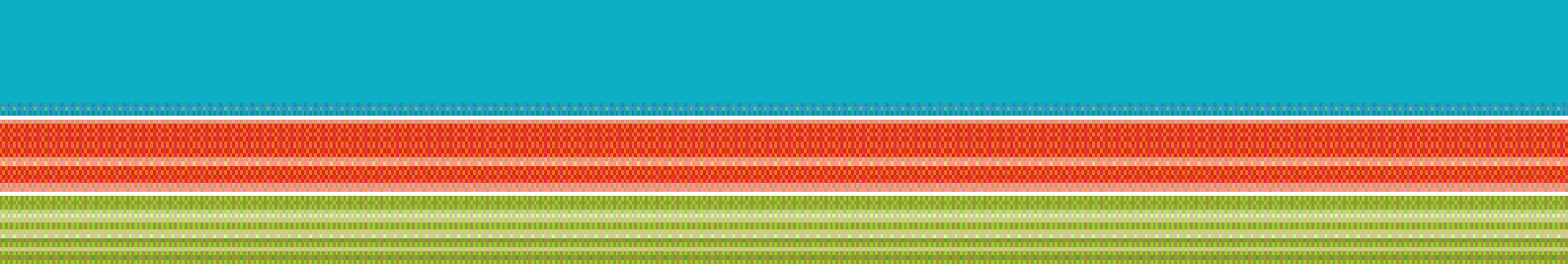
Share the information with the rest of the class. Each group could be asked to feed back on one of the pictures
What questions could you ask about each picture?

Evaluation:

Understanding of the global links between people and places
