You will need to know a lot about animals

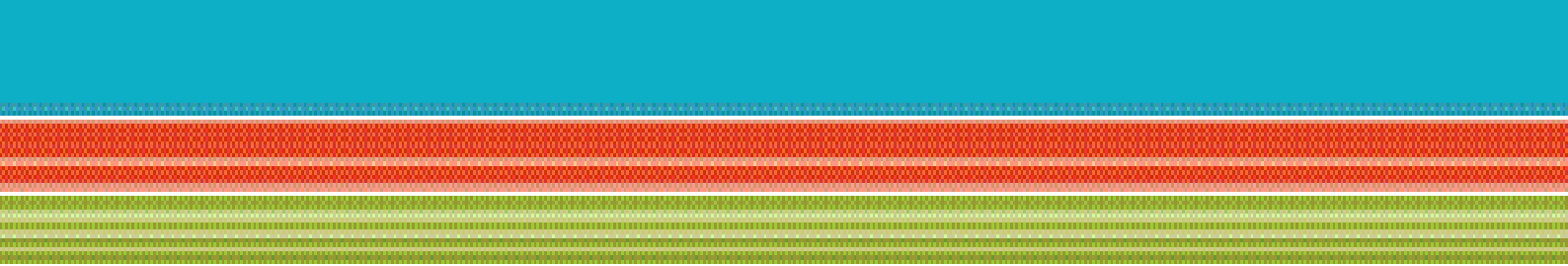
